

## **MSC Grand Voyages from Philipsburg to Genova on March 27, 2022 (MSC Seaview)**

Before booking your cruise, please check [HERE](#) if you are allowed to embark according to your country of residence. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, there might be international travel restrictions depending on your cruise destination and your country of residence.

The below requirements are valid for current and following sailings (health and safety measures are subject to change and will adapt according to the evolution of the pandemic). For more information please call our Contact Centre.

Please note that all Guests will need to follow all of these requirements to be allowed on board:

- All Guests (2 years old and over) embarking in St. Marteen need to provide a certificate of a negative RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours before embarkation. If you embark on your cruise at 15:00 on a Saturday, you should take your COVID-19 test on the Thursday as of 15:00. If this is not possible guests must submit a negative RT-PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to embarking the ship plus a negative antigen test taken 24 hours prior to embarking.
- All Guests (2 years old and over) embarking in St Lucia – Castries arriving by flight will need to provide the vaccination certificate, a certificate of a negative RT-PCR test taken within 48 hours before embarkation (or an antigen test taken within 24 hours before embarkation). Guests must also complete the Health Questionnaire.
- All Guests (2 years old and over) embarking in Bridgetown (Barbados), regardless of vaccination status, including travelers in transit, must have a valid negative Rapid COVID-19 PCR test result taken within 1 day prior to arrival or a negative RT-PCR COVID-19 test result done within 3 days prior to arrival. The test must be taken at an accredited lab and must be from a nasopharyngeal or oropharyngeal sample. Rapid antigen/antibody, self-administered tests, and home kits are not accepted for travel to Barbados. - All Guests (12 years old and over) have to be fully vaccinated. Guests are considered fully vaccinated if they received the full set of vaccine shots more than 14 days before the start of the cruise with an approved Covid-19 vaccine including Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson. The Novavax vaccine is accepted only as booster after 2 doses of mRNA vaccines (Pfizer or Moderna), not as primary Covid-19 vaccine cycle. A “mix-and-match” combination of the above list of vaccines is accepted. All Guests embarking on a cruise must present a vaccination certificate indicating that complete vaccination has taken place within the last 9 months from the second dose (6 months for Italian residents). The vaccination certificate must be valid for the duration of the entire cruise. NOTE: 2 doses of a non-EMA approved vaccine plus an EMA approved booster will be accepted for embarkation only if the booster was given a minimum of 28 days after the second vaccine shot and within 6months of completing the vaccine cycle.
